- Migration and Integration in the Eastern Partnership and the Baltic Sea Region: Policy and Administrative Challenges for the Development of Inclusive Societies (September–November), Gothenburg University and Georgian Institute of Public Affairs
- Sustainable Public Management (May–June), Malmö University
- Transnational Public Administration and Organising (June–August), Södertörn University

- Aspire to work for modern sustainable governance and grow your network of like-minded professionals.
- Are in a position within policymaking, public administration or civil society.
- Are a young professional up to 35 years old.
- Have a good working knowledge of English.
- Are a citizen and resident of Armenia, Belarus, Estonia, Georgia, Latvia, Lithuania, Moldova, Sweden and Ukraine.
